The Executive Engineer, DPHE, Tangail Division, Tangail, Bangladesh now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the **Construction of 5 Public Toilets, 18 Community Latrines, 1 Sludge Treatment Plant, 1 Solid Waste Composting System, 30 communal bins & 1 Solid Waste Sorting Shed in Ghatail Pourashava (Municipality) of Tangail District** under “Urban Water Supply and Sanitation in 23 Pourashavas Project in Bangladesh (GOB-IDB)” (“the Works”). The works will be implemented in Ghatail Pourashava of Tangail District, Bangladesh.
