The **Government of the Republic of Sierra Leone** has received a loan, Istisna'a and TA Grant financing from the Islamic Development Bank and Islamic Solidarity Fund for Development (ISFD) towards the cost of **Palm Oil Production Project in Sierra Leone in the Framework of Capacity Building**, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this financing to payments under the Contract for the Procurement for the Design, Construction, Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning and handover of 10 Ton FFB/HR Palm Oil Mill in Kembaloh, Jong Chiefdom, Bonthe District, Sierra Leone. Bidding will be governed by the Islamic Development Bank procurement rules and procedures.
2. The Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry (MAF) now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for:
Design, Construction, Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning and Handover of 10 Ton FFB/HR Palm Oil Mill in Kembaloh, Jong Chiefdom, Bonthe District, Sierra Leone.
3. Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) procedures specified in the Islamic Development Bank Guidelines: Procurement under IDB financing, and is open to all bidders from IDB member countries (MCs), as defined in the guidelines.
4. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from **Project Management Unit, Palm Oil Production Project in Sierra Leone in the Framework of Capacity Building, Youyi Building, Brookfields, 1st Floor, Room E105, Freetown** and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below from 08.30AM to 5.00 PM.
5. Qualification requirements include among others: (i) Annual turn-over of US\$ 6,000,000; (ii) sound financial position; (iii) Bidder (s) must have engaged in contract (s) for supply/construction of same or similar goods in the last five (5) years; (iv) participated as contractor, management contractor, or subcontractor, in at least two (2) contracts within the last four (4) years; each with a value of at least US\$ 4,000,000 that have been successfully and substantially completed and that are similar to the proposed Works; (v) possess manufacturer's authorization certificate where sought for items; (vi) is a nationally registered business with obligations related to taxes/ NASSIT etc fulfilled (national firms).
6. A complete set of Bidding Documents in **English** may be purchased by interested bidders on the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **Five Hundred United States Dollars (USDS 500.00)** or its **equivalent in Sierra Leone Leones**. The method of payment will be by cash to Oil Palm Production Project O.I.C.C.B Account No.: 601041222 at the Zenith Bank Sierra Leone Limited, Rawdon Street, Freetown Branch. The Bidding Documents may be collected by hand at address below upon provision of the bank receipt.
7. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before **1:00 PM. 9th October, 2019**. Electronic bidding will not be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders or their representatives who choose to attend in person at the address below at **1:00 PM. 9th October, 2019**. All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security of Seventy Thousand United States Dollar (70,000 USD) or its equivalence in Sierra Leone Leones (SLL) at the time of payment.
